Thomas Fone DCLG has responded and suggested an approach to LPA about CIL and Training (which we are awaiting a response from Wendy Perera) and bear in mind offer to work with DCLG to review the effectiveness of Neighbourhood Plans.

4. GREEN TOWNS UPDATE

Spring Litter Pick on Saturday 16th April 10.00am at Steyne Park. Kingswood have been invited.

Looking at the Culver Trail boards and potential grant funding to replace missing boards and those in need of an upgrade. 10 boards in total which were originally installed with a £25K Heritage lottery grant but not included on the rolling maintenance programme or asset register.

BB7 vegetation has been cleared. Checking with ROW if further works are to be carried out plus discussions about priorities of future maintenance projects.

Best Kept Village Awards judging commences 1st May. Write to judges to let them know that Lincoln Way Pond is now owned and maintained by the Parish Council to be included.
