IWASP

Latest scams to be aware of from IWASP. All warnings come from Trading Standards so are genuine.



- Reports received of a scam call purporting to be the Postcode Lottery. The caller
 asks for personal information and often bank details to receive the winnings! If you
 aren't sure if it's a scam call find the genuine number for the company and phone them to check if you are a winner!!
- A call purporting to be O2, offering rewards for being a loyal customer. They say they are sending a one time passcode and you need to verbally tell the caller rather than putting it into the app. This gives the scammer access to your information.
- Reports are coming in from vulnerable residents who receive a call trying to replace their Wightcare package the caller says the current package is no longer be available (this isn't true) and they try to sell you a new one asking for bank details. Please be aware of companies trying to offer similar care packages, they are very often scammers.

These are all examples of prolific phone scams, if you are in receipt of scam telephone calls please consider call blocking. Sky, Talk Talk or Wightfibre all offer a FREE call blocking service to their customers. If not you can purchase call blocking phones that can do the same function. These measures can block up to 98% of unwanted scam calls keeping us safe from these unwanted calls.
